PSAT, October 11, 2023. (11th Grade only) PSAT stands for the Pre-Scholastic Aptitude Test, the results assist students in anticipating their performance on college entrance tests. High test scores are used to determine the National Merit Scholars for 11th grade. Birdville ISD will purchase PSAT tests for all 11th graders. All 11th graders have been provided with a test preparation booklet through English teachers.

RECOMMENDATIONS by teachers and/or counselors will be required for some colleges and scholarships. Please allow at least two weeks to write a favorable letter. The "Request for a Recommendation Letter" form is available in Counselor Connections through Canvas. Paper copies are available in the counseling office. **Plan ahead**!

Should you choose to send counselors the recommendation forms electronically, please provide resume information to your counselor and follow up with your counselor to insure the forms arrived and there are no questions that need to be answered for completion.

NCAA CLEARINGHOUSE is required for student athletes wishing to play Division 1 or 2 sports in college. Students must register on-line at <u>www.ncaa.org</u>. Then request a transcript through Parchment.com. Recruiters for Division I and II <u>cannot</u> visit with students without complete clearinghouse information.
